'MACOS': SPAWN, <whatever the Mac command is> 'WIN': SPAWN, <whatever the Windows command is> 'VMS': SPAWN, <whatever the VMS command is> ELSE: 'IDL on PDP 11/70 is no longer supported :o)'

ENDCASE

Of course the non-unix results for !VERSION.OS_FAMILY above are made up. :o)
