I'll assume the display device is correctly set to the window you wish to convert to a postscript file.

IDL> image = tvrd() ; read the data from the current graphics window

IDL> set_plot, 'ps' ; set the plot device to postscript

IDL> tv, image ; display the data into the postscript file (idl.ps)

IDL> device, /close ; close the device (add'l info sent to idl.ps)

See Chapter 3, "IDL Graphics Devices" of the IDL Reference Guide for a description of the keywords available for postscript devices. There is quite a bit of info in there regarding scaling and color mapping.
