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I know it is probably in one or more of the manuals, but I spent several hours yesterday trying to save an image to a TIFF file using PV-WAVE Command Language. I was able to produce a window on screen with image I wanted using TVSCL on double precision data, but I couldn't use TVRD to read that image from the screen (I am using an IPX SUN Sparc-station running Solaris, Openwindows 3.3). So my question is simply: how do I get from an image on the screen to having an "image array" with either the colour table or RGB data that I can save to disk in TIFF format (and just where in the manuals does it describe this)?
