If you are having the same problems as I, then I can probably answer you - from the accumulated wisdom from reading what others wrote in reply to my initial question.

Prob. a) The display being eaten up

Soln : Go to preferences in the IDLDE menu and change the "backing store"

Prob. b) The help not working

Soln: One has to brand the ELF libraries. This is something I forgot to do in FreeBSD while installing IDL("brandelf -t Linux idl-elf-files"). I suppose there must be a way to brand ELF in Sun.

Once again thanks to all who responded to my question. IDL is running without any trouble on BSD. It is a pity that it is not officially recognised by the RSI co..
