HDF provides routines for deleting or renaming > Vgroups, but not for anything else. HDF DELDD doesn't actually delete an > object from an HDF file, it just removes it from the list of data > descriptors. The deleted object still takes up space (which can be > released by using the hdfpack routine). > Excellent, thanks for the info. Next question: does anyone have a good HDF to NetCDF converter? ;-) Dan
