HDF isn't good about deleting or renaming things. The best you can do is create a new file by copying all the parts of the old file that you want to keep, while dropping or renaming the parts you want to drop or rename. Very annoying. HDF provides routines for deleting or renaming Vgroups, but not for anything else. HDF_DELDD doesn't actually delete an object from an HDF file, it just removes it from the list of data descriptors. The deleted object still takes up space (which can be released by using the hdfpack routine).
