A word of warning for RSI tech support, though - I have not been persistent in reporting bugs and user interface ugliness in the Linux version because I have been developing on the Mac. The Mac interface has been much nicer than the Linux interface, so I simply minimized my exposure to the Linux interface. If I do start using the OS X version, and if it does inherit to interface bugs and ugliness of the Linux version, I'll be complaining.

Who knows, maybe I will check to see if the OS X version of emacs is anything other than ugly...
