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Use XYOUTS

like this:

XYOUTS, x_coord, y_coord, 'Your title here'

You can add keywords /Device or /Normal (or /Data, which won't be valid if you only TVSCL'd, since no data coords were set up)

You can also add an Alignment keyword to tell it to center, left, or right justify the text about the coordinate point. Use Alignment=0 for left, =1 for right, =0.5 for center.

So, you can do something like this

TVSCL, image

XYOUTS, image_width / 2, image_height, 'Title', Align=0.5, /Device

Add a bit to the height to move the title up off the top of the image.

Also add CharSize keyword to make the title bigger.
