> breakpoint and navigate the call stack with C-c C-d C-Up. This is even
> nicer, because you can see the context of each call in the code itself,
> print variables local to that stack level, etc.

For those of us deprived of the luxury of using the Wave, you can resort also to inserting a breakpoint in the IDL DE and look up the call stack. Breakpoints in DE have nice features such as conditional breaking, breaking on the counter, etc.
