Since posting my query I have been in contact with the author. Here is a summary of his communication.

- 1. The article itself is nearly eight years old and no longer very relevent.
- 2. Consider using SPAWN and interfaces with data files (more portable)
- 3. Again consider using SPAWN and interfaces with data files (porting applications using these external routines to different platforms/compilers is a pain)
- 4. IDL's own documentation on communicating with external programs is much improved.
- 5. There is a good book on the subject of connecting to external routines from IDL: "Calling C from IDL" by Ronn Kling available from the author at http://www.kilvarock.com/books/callingCfromIDL.htm under the author's web site at http://www.rlkling.com/
- 6. The IDL distribution contains examples of using CALL_EXTERNAL which should be consulted.
