Hi All,

I have just installed 5.5 and came across an error I hadn't seen in 5.4.

I use a 'PRO_SET_VALUE' routine to create a button each time I load an image file. This button's UVALUE carries information about the file and serves as a launching button for the file it represents. At the end of the routine I use WIDGET_CONTROL to send an event to the just created button to make it the 'currently' active button and update some display labels. Unfortunately IDL comes back with the following message:

% WIDGET_CONTROL: Request not allowed on unrealized widget.

This seems strange as the button must be realized, albeit implicitly, since it appears on screen!

Any ideas how I might prevent the error?
