> If you create a button and then call Widget_Control on it in the same
> routine, this button is not realized yet, I think. You can check on that
> by inserting a breakpoint before the end of the routine and checking if
> your button is displayed.

Been there, done that : The button is displayed!

I also tried adding a NOTIFY_REALIZE routine to the button to perform the SEND_EVENT, it never gets called! I'm beginning to think this is specific to WIDGET_CONTROL since WIDGET_INFO is able to return the button's UNAME ...

... Some time later ...

A little experimentation shows it to be even stranger, WIDGET_CONTROL is still able to perform GET_UVALUE but not SET_UNAME. The latter is critical to my application. If XMANAGER is set to BLOCK whilst the code is running then although errors are generated and displayed, the actions are performed!

Help, I'm confused >:(
