Greetings -

I am a new user of IDL and would love some help. I am trying to load a bunch of tiff's into xinteranimate to view them as an animation.

However, once I load roughly 120 of them I get an error saying there is no space left in the buffer, and it tosses me out. (IDL typically crashes then as well)

I am running version 5.5 in classic mode of Mac OS X. I have 1.5gig of mem in the machine, and according to top there is almost a gig of free memory when this happens, so it seems to be an internal buffer which I am filling.

Any help on this prob. would be great, or point me to other widgets which may already handle my animation issues, if that is a fesible solution.....
