I think the key here is, anything in parenthesis gets *evaluated* and as such is an expression. And it is not really surprising that one is not allowed to assign a value to an expression. This is the strength of IDL - it creates temporary variables as expressions, and allows to use them just like named variables. Unlike, say, IGOR Pro that requres you to define a named variable to even plot it.
