> I have tricked IDL into producing the tick labels in the format I want by  
> changing the !X.TICKNAME to:  
>  
> !X.TICKNAME=['0','15','30','45','60','75','90','75','60','45 ','30','15','0']  
>  
> I'd still like to know the correct way.

I'm not sure that is much of a trick. More like what the documentation called for, it seems to me. :-)

But shouldn't !X.Ticks be 12 and not 13? Then you wouldn't have to use the !X.TickV variable at all, I think.
