> In IDL 5.4 the result was: image[100,1]
> In IDL 5.5 the result is: image[100]
>
> Is there anything known about a bug fix for that?

of the REFORM you should be set. :-)

IDL>
IDL> array = INDGEN(100)
IDL> a=reform(array, 100, 1)
IDL> help, a
A          INT      = Array[100, 1]
```
