The following does not do what I want:

IDL> FOR
$$i = 0$$
, 10 DO PRINT, i, FORMAT = "(\$, 'i = ', I4, T1)"
 $i = 0i = 1i = 2i = 3i = 4i = 5i = 6i = 7i = 8i = 9i = 10IDL>$

The \$ supresses the newline, but T1 does not reposition the pointer to the beginning of the line.

I would like to see:

Where "i = 10" has overwritten "i = 9", etc.
