> IDL> FOR i = 0, 10 DO PRINT, i, FORMAT = "(\$, 'i = ',I4, T1)"
> i = 0i = 1i = 2i = 3i = 4i = 5i = 6i = 7i = 8i = 9i = 10IDL>
>
> The \$ supresses the newline, but T1 does not reposition the
> pointer to the beginning of the line.
>
> I would like to see:
>
> IDL> FOR i = 0, 10 DO PRINT, i, FORMAT = "('i = ',I4, ??????)"
> i = 10
>
> Where "i = 10" has overwritten "i = 9", etc.
>
