> In 3.1 of Wave, a new keyword, WINDOW_STATE, is now available. WINDOW_STATE  
> will return an array for all available WAVE windows, with a value indicating  
> if a window is opened or closed. A value of 1 shows the window is open, and 0,  
> the window is closed. As an example for using this keyword, enter:  
>  
> WAVE> window, 3 ; Open window 3  
> WAVE> device, window_state = winarray  
> WAVE> print, winarray  
> 0 0 0 1 0 0 0 0 0 0 0  
> 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0  
> 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0 0  
>
```

It's interesting to note that this feature is not in my documentation that came with WAVE 3.1. When I inquired to my tech support a few months ago I was told that this "fix" is being worked on and not in 3.1.

What gives? Now I'm wondering what other "undocumented" features are in 3.1?
