> findfile() last week and everything worked out fine. Today, it returns no  
> files, even with

> Yet \$ls shows all the files in the current directory.  
>  
> Has anyone come across this?

Apart from the issue Dave mentions, the only time I have seen anything similar to this is if the system disk is full. findfile() spawns a ls process to get the file list, holding it in a temporary file on disk. If there isn't sufficient space on the disk to hold the list of files the results from findfile() are somewhat random.

How full is your system disk?
