From David Fanning's site, try this UNDEFINE routine.

Andrew Cool

```
PRO UNDEFINE, varname
tempvar = SIZE(TEMPORARY(varname))
END
```

You use it like this:

```
IDL> a = BYTARR(200,200)
IDL> HELP, a
```

```
A  BYTE = Array(200, 200)
```

```
IDL> UNDEFINE, a
IDL> HELP, a
```

```
A  UNDEFINED = *Undefined*
```
