Dear Dom,

for example

```
arr=double(2000,2000)
```

```
arr=temporary(arr)+1  will not duplicate arr by adding 1
```

if you do

```
b=temporara(arr)
```

arr is undefined and b is the double array

```
b=0b
```

deletes the type and dimension of b and it is only
1 byte long.
