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Hi,

I have a problem using a color table on Red Hat Linux 7.1. I have downloaded the patch available at the rsinc website to resolve the striping effect, but there is one more problem.

Any image that I display (for e.g. with a plot/plots command), shows up in black and white. When I call xloadct or annotate and place my mouse on the colorbar, I get flashing colors.

What do I need to do to get rid of this problem? My graphics card supports 24-bit true (direct) color.
