> 0.00

> I'd like to print the values on one line, not 3 for example.  
> Does anybody have any ideas?

Yes, try this:

IDL> print, t, format='(\$, f10.2)'

The \$ will suppress the newline implied by the closing parenthesis.  
Hope this helps.
