> IDL> t={a:0.,b:0.,c:0.}
> IDL> print,t
> { 0.00000 0.00000 0.00000}
> IDL> print,t,format='(3f10.2)'
> 0.00
> 0.00
> 0.00
>
> I'd like to print the values on one line, not 3 for example.
> Does anybody have any ideas?

Yes, try this:

```
IDL> print, t, format='($, f10.2)'
```

The \$ will suppress the newline implied by the closing parenthesis.
Hope this helps.
