Hello all,

Does anyone have a technique to get the PostScript driver to do a shaded fill pattern with POLYFILL? There's the mysterious FILL_PATTERN keyword, but it seems to have no effect on the PostScript driver, which is strange since patterned fills should be a piece o' cake in PS, and many drawing programs provide standard fill patterns, including various percentages of even fill (for example, I'd like a 30% fill of red on a polygon). A bit of trial and error (mostly error) with the PATTERN keyword provided similar output. Line filling works, but I'd like something snazzier.
