I'd like to ask if anyone has created a Microsoft C (v6.0) DLL and accessed Callable IDL (v5.3) from it. The examples in the IDL distribution show an 'hinstance' being passed around. Since my software is strictly an instrument driver with no windows, I have no idea of how to obtain this variable. The text-based communication that Callable IDL provides is adequate for what I wish to do. The example that I am working with is:
