> I have wondered whether Adobe Illustrator or Corel Draw could import

> images, but never got round to finding out. Your experience suggests

> they don't.

For the record, Corel Draw 9 (v9.439) imports PS images created in IDL 5.5 correctly. I don't have Illustrator installed so I can't comment on that but would be happy to send you the 12kb .ps file I created with your test_tv program if you want to give it a try.
