Thanks for the workaround... and the typo find. Your trick works because the base doesn't have /COLUMN or /ROW set, right? I guess a more general version of the same technique would be to create a separate unmapped TLB with a draw widget.

Since I know you don't use Macs often, you probably could not see the cursor change problem. The !Window thing wasn't a typo, technically--I rarely ask for the index of the current direct graphics window, so I had forgotten that it was a field in the !d structure. !Window worked, so I just left it. What is !Window, anyway? It seems to be the short integer version of the long !d.window, although a quick "? !Window" command does not show any help on it.
