Hot on the heels of the large IDLWAVE 4.13 release, which was haunted by triskaidekaphobia, version 4.14 cleans up a few of the new features and includes a few bug fixes:

- \* Better handling of multiple \*Examine\* buffer windows, allowing you to resize them without it being auto-sized on each examine. A frame containing \*Examine\* with only one window will be used preferentially.
- \* Key commands "c" and "q" clear the old contents and close the current \*Examine\* window, respectively.
- \* Continued statements at the end of continuation lines, ala:

now have indentation correctly calculated.

\* Class-qualified method procedure calls now have continued indentation correctly calculated:
