Hi,

The gen\_write and gen\_read routines are under development to facilitate passing data between IDL, MatLab, and (eventually) LabView. These are modeled after Liam Gumley's slick BinRead and BinWrite routines. These use standard tags that describe the data size, endian-ness, row/column major ordering and an optional tag. They have not been tested much. The format is *\*not\** .m file nor the IDL .sav file formats.
