> You can access the sub-array like this:  
>  
> good = where( data NE -9999 )  
> data = data[ good ]
```

Ken is absolutely right, but because you are a newbie,
I feel an obligation to get you started in the right
direction. I would write the code like this:

```
good = where( data NE -9999, count )  
IF count GT 0 THEN data = data[ good ]
```

That will save you a couple of headaches down the road. :-)
