> What's strange is that the program runs without any hitches from within
> IDL, but if ran as part of a script with 'idl pro-name.pro' it crashes.
> I've included the start of the code below. The rest, not included, is just the plotting
> stuff. maybe you can see something ?

Well, I'm perplexed. This code didn't generate those errors unless no files were found in the location you were looking for them. :-)

Why don't you set a breakpoint and step through your code, examining things as you go. That's the best way to discover these kinds of errors.
