> accept any useful arguments such as the window position and size, thus
> making it clumsy to use for this purpose.

You can use xwd. You can specify either the resource ID or WM_NAME of the window you want to capture. If you set the title of the base widget you can use:

```
xwd -name 'title_of_your_base_widget' > widgetcapture.xwd
```

IDL can read the X Windows dump format file with READ_XWD.
