The question is how do you make *any* GIFs in IDL? Older version of IDL are able to make GIFs, and animated GIFs are documented in WRITE_GIF.

If you have some older versions of IDL lying around, then it may be possible to take the GIF dlm from the old version and copy it to your new version directory, and then be able to use it. The only way to find out is to try it.

If it is something you are willing to pay for, I believe that RSI offers a GIF licensing option.
