> (e.g. OK = EXECUTE(".RUN foo.pro") does not work)

Just to clarify, I want the compilation to be done somewhere at
run-time, say when a user selects a given menu item. Note that the '@'
command to include a file doesn't do this, it just includes another
file as part of the current file.
