- > Now, whatever I do, I always get the error message
- > % Internal error: Triangulation is invalid.
- > This is pretty independent of whether I construct my triangles "by hand"
- > or via the "triangulate,..." procedure.

- > Any ideas on what this means, how I can get more explicit error
- > messages, or a workaround?

Try scaling your data (multiply it by 100 or something). I think this error most often appears when triangle vertices are coincidental (probably because of round-off error).
