> What I really need to do is something like this:

> s = sprintf('SIZE(%s, /%s)', arrayname, somekeyword)

> So if arrayname is A and somekeyword is TYPE, then the resulting string
> would be

> 'SIZE(A, /TYPE)'

So why not write

s='size('+arrayname+',/'+somekeyword+')'
