I have been working with Julian dates and would like to label animation frames with date and time expressed as mm/dd/yyyy hh:mm:ss. I can get the values for month, day, year, hour, minute and second using CALDAT, but they are widely spaced, and when I add '/' or ':' I get something like:

7/        26/        1981        6:        17:        56

instead of 7/26/1981 6:17:56.

How can I create variables without spaces from CALDAT output to get normal looking text?
