Hi,

using arrow to recall a ligne seems to be broken under rh8.0/gnome-terminal. I cant go back trought history line or just move cursor left. Do you have experienced the problem?

I've just made some little investigation using strace:

under rh 7.3, when i hit the left arrow key, i've got:

```
read(0, "\33", 1) = 1

read(0, "[", 1) = 1

read(0, "D", 1) = 1
```

but under 8.0, its:

```
read(0, "\33", 1) = 1

read(0, "O", 1) = 1

read(0, "D", 1) = 1
```

so "[" became "0". something is mapped by gnome-terminal, who is confusing idl. I've try to disable KeyBinding and default profile, without succes.

Other applications seems to work well (tcsh, matlab, perldl, octave etc...)
