There's also a tool to convert Emacs buffers to HTML, with all background and faces, etc. -- htmlize:

XEmacs bundles it, I believe. Keep in mind that in IDLWAVE, keywords on continuation lines are correctly highlighted only on global font-lock passes (like when you first load the buffer, or if you explicitly font-lock-fontify-buffer).
