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Hello,

I have a program that draws some graphics to an off-screen buffer then grab the image and save it to JPEG file. It runs fine on my SGI machine with IRIX 6.5.17.

When I telnet from to the SGI from a Windows machine at home and run the program, it works as long as I leave my account at the SGI is till open. If I have logged out from the SGI and tried the program by telnet from home, it crashes at the statement:

```
WINDOW, /PIXMAP, /FREE
```

and give the following error:

```
% WINDOW: Unable to connect to X Windows display: 0.0
```

```
% WINDOW: Unable to open X Windows display.
```

Has anyone encountered similar problem and know a work-around?
