Even if you got syntax coloring to work, it would still be great to have a "compile" button and an "execute" button in the text window, as in the IDL environment on 5.4 (& 5.5?). Plus there's that great feature that when there's a breakpoint or a crash, the editor opens up the proper file and takes you to the offending line. Would that be possible in BBEdit?

I think I'm going to have to learn emacs over the holidays. vi won't cut it any longer.
