Definitely. You use the IDLDBDatabase object's Connect method. It takes CONNECTION or DATASOURCE keywords. Looking back over some old code I see that I connected to a database with the commands

objDB = OBJ\_NEW('IDLdbDatabase')
objDB->Connect, datasource='\$Station Data'

Unfortunately I do not recall how I set up a data source called '\$Station Data'. I think this pointed to an .mdb file and that I set up the data source via the ODBC Control Panel (Windows).

Hope this helps.
