> How do I suppress the numbers at the tickmarks when using plot ?
> I thought it was charsize=-1, but that doesn't seem to work.

Hello.
Try using keyword, `[xy]tickname`.
For example:

```
IDL> x=findgen(10)
IDL> y=findgen(10)
IDL> label=replicate(' ',10)
IDL> plot,x,y,xtickname=label
```

With this execution, you can suppress the tickmarks of x-axis.
The elements of `label` are all space, ' '.
