I don't have my full code here at work, but it basically looks like:

dicomdir = OBJ\_NEW('IDLffDICOM', 'D:\dicomdir') PatientName = dicomdir->GetValue('0010'x, '0010'x)

So PatientName is an array of 'PtrHeapVariables', which I want to compare with a user entered parameter to determine where to start reading the images/filenames.

What I tried was various combinations of:

StartOffset = WHERE(\*PatientName EQ 'blah');

StartOffset = WHERE((\*PatientName) EQ 'blah');

StartOffset = WHERE(\*PatientName[\*] EQ 'blah'); etc.

however, I only get error messages, so end up having to use a FOR loop to find the starting location.
