I've been corresponding with a friend for the past 24 hours trying to get something other than red to show up in an HP Color Laserjet 5M printer. Anyone have experience with that? I'm guessing that the printer is taking the color index as a 24-bit value, but DEVICE, DECOMPOSED=0 is not a valid keyword for this PRINTER device. Sigh...

Maybe this is the *opposite* problem from what we have been discussing in this thread. Maybe attacking this from both ends will get RSI's attention. :-)
