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How can I add the NEEDED d to get this:

2452662.305203d

out of this:

```
maxtime = jul2cal((data(0,maxgust_time)), /TO_STRING, /MDY)
```

In my program (data(0,maxgust_time)) fetches 2452662.305203 out of the array, but if I don't add the d to the julian date it calculates the wrong time in the above statement.

I've tried

```
maxtime = jul2cal((data(0,maxgust_time))d, /TO_STRING, /MDY)
```

but that's not accepted.

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
