- > continue to work and makes the work on Windows "smoother" while IDL is
- > running.

This is interesting, and suggestive, too. I wonder if the ability to break into WHILE loops was added when management of widget programs was taken out of XManager. Makes sense that you would have to check back to the command line periodically to see if a widget event was waiting to be processed. If so, this would be the first ever evidence of a positive benefit from allowing users access to the IDL command line when widget programs were running. :-)
