  del_file,'data.sql'  
  put_file,'data.sql',txt
```

```
SPAWN,'mysql -h 127.0.0.1 -u data -P3306 < data.sql',result
```

Is it possible to write a dlm using mysql as it is now with parameter submission I did by spawn in this example?

Another nice command is

```
mysqlshow --host=127.0.0.1 --user=data
```
